Crystal Brook Energy Park – One-on-one Meetings

Neoen is developing and planning the Crystal Brook Energy Park, a renewable energy storage project located approximately 23 kilometres southeast of Port Pirie and 3 kilometres north of Crystal Brook in South Australia.

The Crystal Brook Energy Park is a world-leading renewable energy project combining storage, solar and wind. The aim of this project is to develop an economically and environmentally sound project, providing reliable and dispatchable renewable energy to be used locally and exported through the national grid. The project will generate approximately 767,000 Megawatt hours of renewable electricity every year which is enough to power approximately 20% of all households in South Australia.

The Energy Park project will include:

- A battery with a capacity of 30MW – 100MW.
- A solar farm with a capacity of 50 – 100MW.
- A wind farm of up to 50 turbines.

Neoen is committed to fair and open engagement with the local community around the Crystal Brook Energy Park. We will be consulting with the local community and a wide number of stakeholders to provide information on the project as it develops and to seek valuable input into the final design.
